Principal Message:

Dear Corpus Christi Families,

Thank you to those of you who were able to attend all or some of our Family Week activities last week. It was a great opportunity to have some fun and come together to celebrate the power of family relationships. You are all a very important part of our community, the Corpus Christi family! Thank you Mrs Vanessa for organising the week and to all of the staff for their support

Last week we began the process of interviewing our Prep 2025 families. It has been a privilege to welcome new families to be a part of our wonderful community. These conversations continue this week.

I am very excited to share with you that we have appointed an architect to work with our community to create a Master Plan for future refurbishments. In order to apply for government grants is it essential that the school has a current Master Plan. This process will involve community consultation. Please stay tuned for opportunities to be a part of this exciting project.

We are facilitating the School Readiness Information session at Corpus Christi on Tuesday 21st May at 6.30pm. If you have a child starting Prep in 2025 this is a great opportunity to hear some helpful tips to prepare your child for school. Please contact the office for further information and to reserve your spot.

As educators it is essential that we remind our community of Child Safe practices. In this newsletter I'd like to remind you of the importance of ensuring that if your child is required to take medication at school that a Medical Authority Form is filled out and returned to the office. We are unable to assist children with medication without the correct documentation. All medication must be stored in the office at all times.

I'd also like to remind you of safe practices at home in regards to medication:

Keep medicine up and away, out of reach and sight of children, even medicine you take every day. Children are naturally curious and can easily get into things, like medicine, if they are kept in places within their reach. Keep all medicines and vitamins where children can't reach or see them.

Consider places where children get into medicine. Children often find medicine kept in purses or benches and bedside tables. Place bags and briefcases on high shelves or hang them on hooks, out of children's reach and sight.

Remember products you might not think about as medicine. Health products such as vitamins, nappy rash creams and even eye drops can be harmful if children get into them.

Store these items out of reach and sight of children, just as you would over the counter and prescription medicines.

Give medicine safely to children. Use only the dosing device that comes with liquid medicine, not a kitchen spoon. When other caregivers are giving your child medicine, write clear instructions about what medicine to give, how much to give and when to give it. Using a medicine schedule can help with communication between caregivers.

Share medicine safety information with family and friends. Teach other caregivers such as family members, babysitters and friends about medicine safety.




