Dear Corpus Christi Families,

Welcome back to Term Four! We have an exciting array of learning activities and events planned. Please be sure to check Storypark and the fortnightly Corpus Christi Chatter for upcoming events.

This term, our Inquiry focus is 'Change Over Time,' and each year level has organised excursions to engage students and enhance their critical thinking on this topic.

On Friday, October 25th, our Year 5/6 students will visit Sovereign Hill to explore the goldfields. They will participate in an educational program that allows them to experience daily life from over 150 years ago and compare it to their own experiences.

Both Foundation/1 and Year 4 classes will embark on excursions on Thursday, November 7th.

- Foundation/1 will visit the Melbourne Museum for a story-led activity titled 'My Grandmother's Toy Box.' Students will connect with Hannah, a storybook character, as she unpacks a family trunk filled with toys passed down through generations, exploring playthings from various historical periods.
- Year 4 will step back in time at Bundoora Park Farm's Heritage Village. With buildings dating back to 1899, they will engage in activities that showcase early 20th-century colonial farm life, complemented by historical photographs and artefacts on display.

To celebrate their learning about school life in the past, present, and future, the Year 2/3 students will have an immersion day on Thursday, December 5th, experiencing school life from the Olden Days.

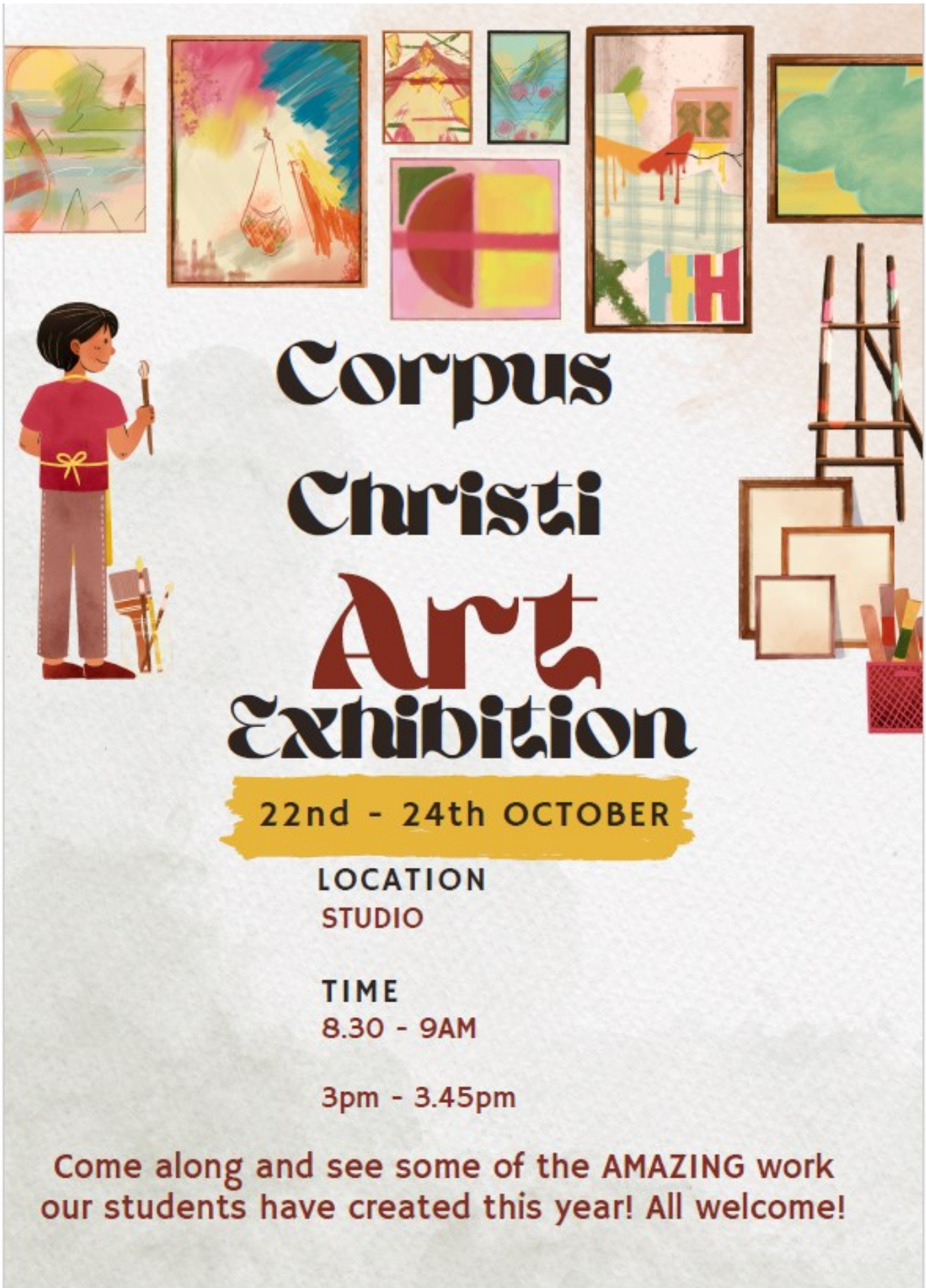
These excursions are crucial to our students' learning experiences. They foster understanding of key knowledge and skills while providing valuable social and emotional development opportunities, such as teamwork, resilience, and problem-solving. Therefore, it is essential for students to attend these days.

Year level overviews for Term 4 were posted on Storypark last week, so please take a moment to familiarise yourself with what your child is learning across different curriculum areas. In the coming weeks, teachers will be conducting assessments in preparation for Semester 2 Reports. **Please note that Monday, November 4th, will be a Pupil Free Day** for teachers to focus on report writing. Regular attendance is important for accurate reporting on your child's progress.
